

Wareham Walkers – Rules

- Walks start promptly at 10.30 am – please be at starting point by 10.25 am.
- Suitable footwear (preferably walking boots) must be worn – no flip-flops!
- The Walk Leaders will prevent you from walking with us if your footwear is inadequate.
- For safety reasons we regret no dogs, pushchairs, wheelchairs or mobility scooters.
- Grandchildren may accompany you during school holidays only.
- Please inform the Walk Leader of any special medical condition not previously disclosed which may affect you on the walk.
- Bring with you any medication you may require during the walk.
- Bring sunscreen and drinking water if you think you may need them.
- Refreshments at the conclusion of the walk are optional – please ensure you have sufficient parking time for this.
- Please take special care when crossing or walking along roads.
- Please endeavour to keep with the other walkers as a group – especially along roads.
- When crossing farm land, please ensure farm gates are closed after use.
- Please inform the Walk Leader and alert other walkers if you spot a particular new hazard.
- Please inform the Walk Leader if you intend leaving the walk before its conclusion.
- For your own safety, please follow all instructions given by the Walk Leaders and Organiser at all times.
